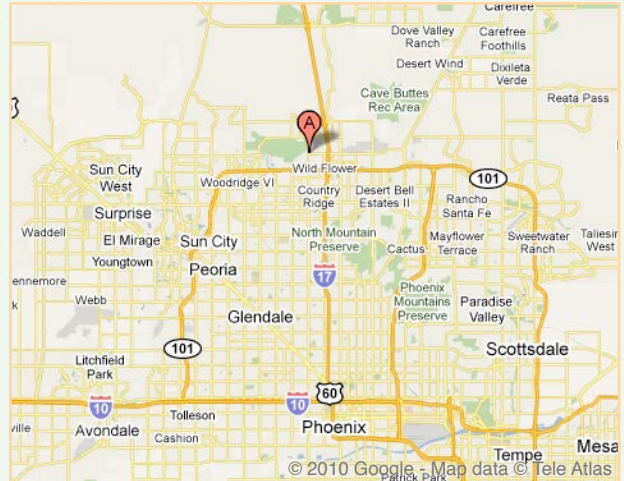


Welcome to Play Ball Country.

Deer Valley Rock Art Center	Mom's Choice** Embracing the beauty and splendor of Native American art and tradition, the Deer Valley Rock Art Center showcases timeless works of art. Additionally, walk away the day while exploring Petroglyph Trail - with ancient carvings and symbols that were created thousands of years ago.	dvrac.asu.edu
Rawhide Wild West Town	The West may not have been won in one day, but you'll see what life was like in less time than that. Catch the bad guy as wily bandits engage in simulated gun fights, or keep your boots clean by hopping aboard a stagecoach. Phoenix Art Museum	Featuring an eclectic collection representative of the diverse cultures found throughout Arizona, the Phoenix Art Museum offers more than 18,000 works of art from nearly every genre. General admission is \$4 for kids under 17, \$10 for adults.	phxart.org

Estrella Mountain Regional Park	A rare combination of wetlands and desert make this regional park a gem tucked just outside city limits. With more than 19,000 acres to explore, Estrella Mountain Regional Park was the first of its kind in Maricopa County. Enjoy hiking, biking, horseback riding by day, or stunning star gazing at night. Springtime will be full of color, as the desert blooms come to life. Admission is \$6 per vehicle.	maricopa.gov/parks/estrella
Hot Air Expeditions	If fresh air is what you crave, it doesn't get much purer than 400 feet above the desert. Deer Valley's Hot Air Expeditions offers families an amazing 360-degree panorama of Monument Valley. Reservations can be handled online; dinner or champagne flights are available.	hotairexpeditions.com
La Parilla Suiza	This local cantina has some of the best southwest-style cooking in all of Phoenix. Try the #1 Especial (tortilla soup with avocado and sour cream) or #32 Pechuga Suiza (chicken breast and cheese between two flour tortillas). Hall of Flame Fire Museum	If you really want to turn up the temps on your visit to the Phoenix area, the Hall of Flame Fire Museum is just the place for your family. With restored fire equipment from as early as 1725, this interactive museum features gear from all over the world. Be sure to tour the "safety house" and help your kids learn about fire hazards, and even slide down a fire pole. Admission is \$6 for adults, \$1.50-\$4 for children and \$5 for seniors	hallofflame.org
